Holidays are a standard work day for our grocery customers so it is a normal day with no bonuses.

- * What is the average length of work day?

10-12 hours is the average but always be prepared to use you full 14.

- * Is it piece by piece unload?

No, all freight is palletized and unloaded by motorized pallet jack.

- * Do we get our own trucks assigned?

No, we run day cabs and are slip seat.

- * When can I get a schedule that has weekends off?

Kroger is a 7 day a week customer that requires holidays and weekends.

If you live within 60 miles of Shelbyville, IN, you could be the perfect dedicated driver to add to our

Kroger team! Some of the best parts of being a dedicated driver are getting home daily, and driving an average of 1700-2000 per week. That's around \$1350 every week and up to \$70k annually. In addition to mileage pay, you'll earn \$55 per trailer for unload and \$20 stop pay.

As part of the Kroger dedicated team, you'll run dry and refrigerated TOUCH freight to various Kroger locations in OH, IN & IL. 100% of freight will be driver unload with pallet jacks at Kroger stores.

To give you the best possible driving experience, the distribution center includes 24/7 on-site staff, including an onsite mechanic Monday, Wednesday, Friday & Saturday.

Runs will include nights, weekends, and holidays that fall within your workweek. Routes also typically require 2-5 stops per route, with possibly running multiple routes per day.

But being a dedicated driver is no easy task. So, the way we see it, you deserve vacation time more than anyone. That's why after a year on the account, you can take a week of paid vacation. After 1 year, you can take 1 week of vacation. And after 3 years, 2 weeks.
